The purpose of the course is to incorporate the study of diversity into that of consumer behavior, with particular concentration on diverse population subgroups based on ethnicity (African-American, Asian-American, Hispanics), religion (Catholics, Jews, Muslims), social class (lower, upper, middle), gender (women, gays, and lesbians), and age (mature Americans). The rationale for the course is that the United States is a consumer society in which the purchase of goods, services, ideas, activities, and experiences influences political, social, and economic life. By 2030, current “minorities” will be the majority of the U.S. population, and their combined buying power is expected to be over \$4 trillion dollars – a sum that has significant economic, social, and marketing implications for the country. Diverse consumers are influenced by the cultural habits of groups to which they belong, and different subgroups have unique patterns of preferences, customs, and values that determine not only what they will buy, but also how they will live. The readings, assignments, fieldtrips and films are designed to build your capacity to understand consumers in different subgroups by experiencing the relationship between diversity and consumption in the world and the media.
